WHAT IS THE TARA IRISH DANCE COMPANY INC?

TIDC is an Incorporated Body under the Associations Act of the Northern Territory and acts as a fundraising committee.

WHAT DO THEY DO?

As a not-for-profit entity, TIDC has been formed to support pupils of the registered business 'Tara Academy' through fundraising for essential items including but not limited to, equipment, costumes and travel expenses.

WHAT DOES MY \$50 PER YEAR ASSOCIATION FEE PROVIDE?

Each dance student who is enrolled at Tara Academy is required to pay a \$50 association fee to become a member. In the case of the student being under the age of 18, the parent/guardian of the child becomes the registered member and is entitled to one vote at any general meeting. Where a family has more than one child enrolled, only one association fee is required.

The association fee goes towards Grade Exams and events including our annual Christmas Hooley.

WHAT DOES THE \$75 PER YEAR COSTUME FEE PROVIDE?

Tara Academy team costumes are required for all students with the exception of Tara Tots and adults. At over \$200 to make, the \$75 per year costume fee helps us pay for new costumes to be made and replaced as needed. This also allows us to purchase additional show costumes in the future .

HOW DO I PAY THIS AND HOW OFTEN?

An invoice will be sent out at the start of the year by the Treasurer. Payment plans are available on request (for example, term by term). Please ensure you provide the correct email address.

I'D LIKE TO BE ON THE FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE, HOW DO I JOIN?

As positions become vacant, they will be advertised accordingly. Prior to the AGM, there will be a call for nominations whereby a member can nominate you in writing to join the committee which then goes to a vote.
